CONSENT ORDER

RCT Case 17/01

TAKE NOTICE that, in respect of the allegations made against Sally Ann Walton CT02393 (the **Registrant**):

- That on 26 Oct 2016, Ms Walton failed to appropriately check the dose of a radioisotope, prior to its administration to Patient A in accordance with DP1 [Radiopharmaceutical Administration Procedure
- Following the administration of the radioisotope to Patient A, she incorrectly recorded the dose administered as 210mq on the Radiopharmaceutical Administration Form (RAR)
- She failed to raise concerns about a potential deviation from the intended radiation dose in accordance with policy DP9 when alerted to the error on, or around, the afternoon of 26 Oct 2016
- She failed to raise concerns in accordance with the policy DP9 about a potential error and deviation from the intended radiation dose for over one week having been alerted to this on 26 Oct 2016
- In the light of 3 and 4 above, failed to act appropriately in her capacity as Site Lead and Radiation Protection Supervisor for the Trust,

1. The Registrant consents to the Professional Conduct Committee removing her name from the Register of Clinical Technologists (RCT)
2. The RCT consents to the making of an Order on those terms, being satisfied that doing so would in all the circumstances be appropriate for the following reasons:
 - a. Removal from the Register is required to protect the public.

ALSO TAKE NOTICE that the Panel, with the consent of the parties and being satisfied that it is appropriate to do so, now makes the following Order:

Removal from the Register

Interim suspension for 18 months to cover a potential appeal.
