	Auditor Comments	You have clearly recorded the benefit to you, your practice and your service delivery in your CPD summary. A good range of reflection to the benefits of each activity to yourself, especially the Mindray visit which had several learning outcomes. It is good to see clear reflections on what you have learnt, and not just a description of the activity. Sometimes a little brief on the reflections – e.g. IPEM PSC meeting on 15/2/18 – but the majority of activities have been adequately reflected upon, which is sufficient for audit. Having specific learning objectives from each activity is a good way to demonstrate the CPD activity has been beneficial, rather than the more generic statements e.g. the PSC meeting on 15/2/18 – were there any new changes you learnt?
